Record the words in your jotter. Underline the vowels in these words.  <b>Spicy-</b> Doorway online-Speller 2- 1200 common words- <b>2<sup>nd</sup> 100</b> list 1, 2 and 3. Record the lists in your jotter. Underline the vowels in these words.  <b>Mild -</b> Go to Doorway online-Speller 2- <b>Medial vowels</b>. Try all of the lists in Medial vowels over the week. Try to write <b>4</b> of the words from the list in your jotter once you have done them online.  <b>(Hot-</b> Try the Boggle activity in the folder.
