


Hello, boys and girls!

<p><b><u>Art and Design/ Mathematics</u></b> <b><u>MAKE</u></b></p> <p>Can you create a menu for your café? You can decide how you want your menu to look.</p> <p>What items will you sell? You might want to sell soups, sandwiches, cakes etc.</p> <p>Using your money skills, create prices for your menu.</p> 	<p><b><u>Social Studies/ Technologies</u></b> <b><u>DO</u></b></p> <p>Challenge - there is an empty building in our Village. The Council have asked you to plan a café that could be used by the community. Think about making it eco-friendly and child friendly.
